



AN UPDATE FROM ANDREW

Last week, we were all reminded of how quickly things can change, as Maury County experienced the effects of severe storms and a destructive tornado on Wednesday night. I am always encouraged by the servant hearts in our congregation, and as soon as the damage took place, people snapped into action. On Wednesday night, a few Graymere members delivered food for first responders, who were working throughout the night. On Thursday, more food was delivered to the fire station for workers. One family was identified who had lost everything in the tornado, and several Graymere members delivered clothes to them. We will also be giving all our contribution over the weekly budget to disaster relief efforts.

Beginning Thursday morning, several were making calls to community leaders to discover ways we could help, and we were asked to wait while workers continued clean up efforts. We now have a specific address where we can work to clean up damage. Those who can work with chainsaws can show up at 1780 Blackburn Lane at 4 pm on Thursday and Friday afternoons. By Saturday, there should be plenty of work to do without tools, so all those who can help clear debris and damage can work there beginning at 8:00 a.m. For purposes of traffic flow, we can park in the New Lasea Church of Christ parking lot and take a Graymere bus to the address. Please contact **Jon Winchester** if you can help. We also realize that many will have graduation activities on Saturday; there will likely be more opportunities to help in the weeks to come.

We also have other ministries at Graymere that will provide opportunities for service. Our clothes closet continues to serve people, and they will continue to be open on Thursdays for the rest of the month. It will be closed during June and July, and it will not be accepting donations during that time. We are also in need of volunteers for the Meals program, beginning in September. On Sunday, we will continue our series, Family Values, with a special message from **Jon David Schwartz**. He will help us focus on how to help our children grow into authentic disciples. 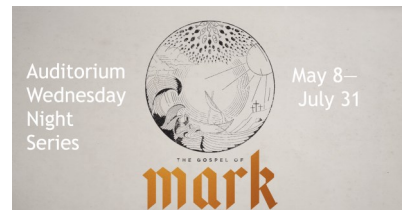
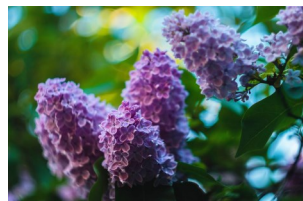
